

Mayor Jerry Lane brought the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Aldermen/Alderwomen present at the meeting were: Garry Swindell, Amelia Salazar and Dave LaRue.


This meeting was called to discuss the reallocation of funds for the balance of the roll offs.

Ms. LaRue was notified by Fire Chief Dennis Massey on Wednesday, June 16th at 8:39 p.m. (following Palisades Special Meeting on June 16th at 6:30pm) that the "Fire Department agreed to pay for ONE roll-off, \$407.02. Mr. Massey stated he did Not agree to pay for half on roll-offs." Historically, the Fire Department has always paid for ½ of the roll-offs during spring and fall cleanups. We were not notified that they would not be paying for ½ of the costs until after the Special meeting on June 16th, where Mr. Massey was not in attendance. Now, the Village of Palisades is responsible for paying the balance of \$1,017.54 that the Fire Department will not be paying. A motion was made by Dave LaRue to utilize funds from the Police budget to pay this costs. Motion was seconded by Amelia Salazar. No one opposed. Remaining balance in the police budget is now ~~\$2,317.82.~~ 2,318.⁰³ *DL*

Dave LaRue made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Amelia Salazar seconded the motion. No one opposed. The meeting adjourned at 6:40 p.m.
